BACKGROUND OF RESEARCH

Example 1: We wish to determine when women who have gestational diabetes are most likely to visit the emergency department during their pregnancy. There will be no age restriction. The index date will be the first visit to the family physician or hospital that confirmed gestational diabetes. Example 2: We wish to determine the prevalence of seasonal flu in Toronto during the 2012/13 flu season among those who received the vaccine and those who did not. Positive lab results from Toronto hospitals and physician offices confirming the 2012/13 seasonal flu strain will be used. Only adults 65 years or older at the time of vaccination will be eligible.
